Happily Ever After Program and Dolly Parton Imagination Library Update



Thanks to Donors like you, kids in Washington County are receiving help with reading at school AND at home!



The Happily Ever After Project is offered in all three county schools. This is an initiative of the Washington County Youth Foundation. Volunteer high school students visit second and third grade classrooms once each week and simply read to the students. Each book read has a lesson plan that focuses on a reading comprehension skill.

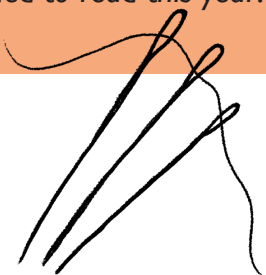
The Dolly Parton Imagination Library is also part of this initiative, but takes place in the child's home. This is a FREE service that is open to all Washington County residents under the age of five. In this program, enrolled children will receive a free, age appropriate book, mailed to their home every month. A child who is signed up at birth will have a library of 60 books by the time they reach the age of five and are ready for Kindergarten. As of December 2023, we have 995 active children and 1,568 children have "graduated" since starting the program in 2015. Thanks to wonderful donors like you, you have helped put over 72,000 books in the hands of Washington County children while helping to improve their lives from such a young age.
