The camp is an intensive, high touch, positive reinforcement experience aimed at at-risk children who display disruptive class behavior, low self-esteem, and mild depression.	\$2,000.00
Project Lifesaver	4 Initial Starter Kits for a search and rescue program for at-risk individuals who are prone to wandering. The individual wears a bracelet on their wrist or ankle that sends out a constant signal that can be picked up by a receiver. If the individual wanders, the caregiver can call 911 and the individual can be located.	\$1,800.00
City of Salem	City of Salem Water Treatment Certified Operator Apprentice Program – aid in the education of employees that can run the Water Treatment Plant through a proactive approach especially considering the amount of money that has been placed into improving the infrastructure.	\$10,000.00
Tri-Kappa	Animal Waste Bag Stations - Providing bags at stations along the walking trail so pet owners will be more responsible for their pets' waste so cleanliness is maintained. Working with the city to formulate a plan for maintaining the stations.	\$3,500.00
Pied Piper	Annie – include children from all three county schools and home-schooled students to perform Annie. Pied Piper has not been able to hold a production since the pandemic.	\$3600.00
Walking Trail Spruce-Up	Upgrade/renovate walking trail with new lights and paint bases.	\$7,000
