Thanks to donors like you, Washington County will be gaining a valuable teammate to the Salem Police Department. The police dog will come fully trained and Patrol Officer, Jordan Taylor, will receive training as well.

Thanks to donors like you, our county will be safer. You helped award a grant to the Salem Police Department during the 2022 Fall Grant Cycle for the purchase of a new K9. Jordan Taylor, Patrol Officer, is excited to receive and train with his new partner. “The entire Salem Police Department is excited to be able to expand our force with the new dog. We plan to assist other agencies throughout the county and region with drug detection. We would also love to go to the schools and educate students on drug prevention as well as making them feel secure when they see a police officer. Thank you to the donors of the Foundation for making this possible.” The dog will be trained in hard surface tracking, criminal apprehension, and drug detection and will be utilized throughout the county. Officer Taylor expects to meet the Malinois in February after he is shipped from Europe and then begin training with the dog this summer.

Your generosity allowed Officer Taylor to reach his goal as well as being able to leverage other grant resources to purchase much needed equipment to house and work with the K9. Because of your generosity and support, Taylor and WCCF staff were able to work together to apply for and receive additional funding opportunities from national organizations such as the AKC, of which, Taylor was awarded a \$7500.00 grant. He also worked diligently at fundraising throughout Washington County in order to alleviate taxpayer burden for the K9 and is so thankful for all the support he has received from our community. We are so thankful for donors like you that make Washington County a better place to live.

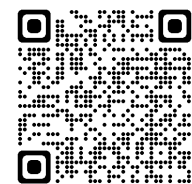

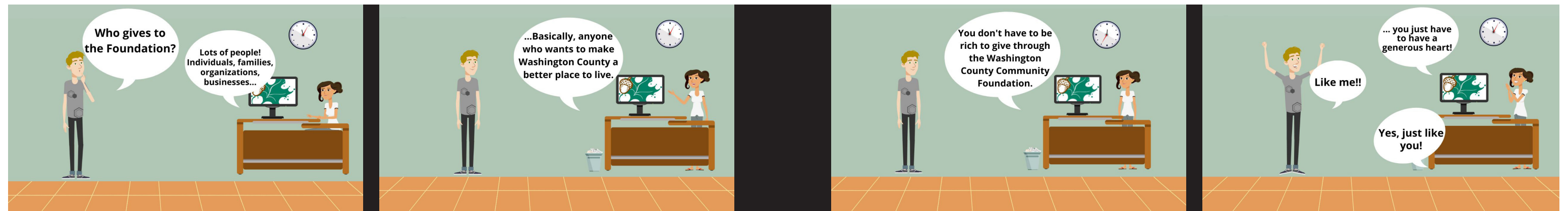

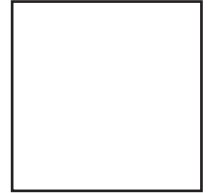
